

All topics and timings are still subject to change. A short description of each format can be found below the table.

MOOCs – Massive Open Online Courses are 4-6 weeks in length and require 12 – 25 hours of learning time during this period. Participants are free to conduct the activities at a time of their convenience during the duration of the course. A certificate is offered upon successful completion.

Short Online Courses – Short Online Courses are 2 weeks in length and require 8 – 12 hours of learning time during this period. Participants are free to conduct the activities at a time of their convenience during the duration of the course. A certificate is offered upon successful completion.

Webinars – Webinars are 1 hour in length and take place at a specific time. No certificate is offered for participation.

Webinar Series – Webinar Series consist of 2 webinars taking place a few days after each other. In between the webinars participants are required to complete an activity. A certificate is offered upon successful completion of the activity and attendance at both webinars.

Online Workshops — Online Workshops are online events with a variety of sessions spread out over 2-3 days. The sessions take place at a specific time. A certificate is offered upon attendance to all workshop sessions. Participation to the workshops is for eTwinners and upon invitation only.

Onsite Workshops – Onsite Workshops are face-to-face events with a variety of sessions spread out over 2–3 days. These sessions include keynote presentations, panel discussions, networking activities, and practical sessions involving group work and discussions. Learning in an onsite course occurs through networking, discussion, and active collaboration with peers during the various sessions as well as the transmission of knowledge from experts presenting during a keynote. Participation in an European School Education Platform Onsite course is only upon invitation by the NSO.
